## Regulation of freedom of expression in the Albanian Constitution

The right to information as one of the basic human rights is regulated by specific provisions in the Constitution of the Republic of Albania<sup>1</sup>, which defines the principles and guarantees citizens the right to information. Within its scope, in Article 23<sup>2</sup>, there is a direct reference to the overall concept which guarantees citizens of the Republic of Albania the right to information, the right to information produced or owned by the state or by persons exercising state functions.

### Measures addressed to internet service providers or to end-users

Art. 17 of the Constitution

- 1. The limitation of the rights and freedoms provided for in this Constitution may be established only by law for a public interest or for the protection of the rights of others. A limitation shall be in proportion with the situation that has dictated it.
- 2. These limitations may not infringe the essence of the rights and freedoms and in no case may exceed the limitations provided for in the European Convention on Human Rights.
