**Implementation of UNGA Resolution 68/166**  
**“International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced**  
**Disappearance“**

a)

The Republic of Serbia ratified the International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearance in April 2011 (*Official Gazette of the RS – International Treaties*, No. 1/2011).

b)

By virtue of Article 3 of the International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearance Ratification Act, the Republic of Serbia has given statements that it recognises the competence of the Committee on Enforced Disappearances in terms of Articles 31 and 32 of the Convention.

c)

During the ratification of the International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearance, the Republic of Serbia did not seek assistance from the United Nations Secretary-General or the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights.

d)

The Republic of Serbia has received no assistance from the stated agencies with respect to the understanding and the implementation of the obligations under this Convention.
