Registration:	<p>All participants must: (i) Register online at https://reg.unog.ch/event/18941/; (ii) Submit an accreditation request letter (letter on official letterhead of the organization, signed by a senior manager, requesting participation of their delegation in the 11th session through the online accreditation system); and (iii) Receive a confirmation of their registration, by email, from the EMRIP secretariat.</p> <p>Participants must obtain a badge upon arrival at the United Nations and before attending the session at:</p> <p>Palais des Nations - Security entrance Pregny Gate, 8 - 14 Avenue de la Paix 1211 Geneva 10</p> <p>Open Monday to Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.</p> <p>You are strongly advised to be at Pregny gate at least one hour in advance of the meeting. You will need to show your passport or other ID as well as the confirmation of your online registration.</p> <p>Visitors cannot enter through the gate at Place des Nations and must make their way to the Pregny Gate.</p>
Travel and visa:	<p>Each participant is responsible for making the necessary arrangements for travel and for obtaining a visa. It is recommended that participants contact the nearest Swiss Embassy or Consulate to determine whether a visa is required (www.eda.admin.ch/eda/en/home/rep.html). Please note that visa application procedures need to be started well ahead of time.</p> <p><u>Participants needing a visa:</u> Please make sure to click on the box stating that you require a visa when you register so that secretariat is aware of your need for a visa and can issue a visa support letter.</p> <p>Please note that the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights will not cover your travel expenses, accommodation, insurance or any other expense which you may incur during your stay in Geneva.</p>
