Following Lisbon Summit (December 2007) MME aims:

- Comprehensive responses to migration and employment challenges with focus on creating more and better jobs for Africa, facilitating mobility and free movement of people
- Better managing legal migration between continents
- Addressing root causes of migration and refugee flows,
- Finding concrete solutions to problems posed by irregular migration flows
- Migration and mobility work for development.



MME some Initiatives

Facilitation of the dialogue

Project launched in 2009.

Will engage in the organisation of *workshops and meetings, information exchange and capacity building.*

Project is implemented by a consortium of three organisations (ICMPD, IDEP, FIIAPP), under the responsibility of a Steering Committee led by AUC and EC, and a consultative role of the Joint Expert Group (JEG).



MME some Initiatives

African Remittances Institute

Currently in preparatory phase towards establishment of African Remittances Institute

Preparatory phase of the project will focus on consultations, research, capacity building and networking



MME some Initiatives

Observatory on Migration

Will create network of research centres and private researchers to provide policy makers, civil society and the public at large with reliable and harmonised data on migration

Decent Work Initiative.

Extending social protection coverage in particular in the informal economy.

AU Programme on Upgrading the Informal Economy and the Productivity Agenda for Africa will continue to provide support to a multi-level dialogue and policy development on the informal economy (mainstreaming of the informal economy, empowerment and social dialogue, productivity improvement, knowledge and data base management, etc).

In cooperation with RECs consultations on thematic policies of common concern, and contribute to enhancing functioning of labour market, supporting harmonization processes of labour and social protection frameworks at regional levels.
